Dress Code

This dress code applies to all MTAC Pasadena Branch events:

Any student who fails to comply with the dress code will not be allowed to perform. No exceptions will be made.

Teachers are expected to convey this clearly to his or her students as well as their parents. Be sure to provide each family with a copy of this dress code well in advance of each event.

Young Ladies:

- * No gum
- * No shorts, jeans, capri pants, carpenter pants, leggings, etc.
- * No T-shirts
- * No tennis shoes, slides, or flip-flops
- * Shoes must have a strap behind the heel
- * No jewelry on wrists or hands
- * No bright nail polish
- * No exposed undergarments (including bra straps)
- * No bare midriff: as a general guideline, if your top hits at the hips, it will cover you adequately as you move at the keyboard
- * Skirts must hit at or be below the knee
- * Hair must be pulled back from your face

Young Men:

- * No T-shirts: a suit is preferable, but a turtleneck or collared shirt with a tie is acceptable
- * No gum
- * No shorts, jeans, capri pants, carpenter pants, etc. Dress pants only.
- * No tennis shoes or flip-flops
- * No jewelry on wrists or hand
- * No exposed undergarments
- * Hair must be pulled back from face
- * No wallet chains
- * Dress shoes and dress socks are required
- * Pants must not hang below hips
